Our vendors offer a wide variety of fresh fruits and vegetables, cut flowers, bedding plants (perennials and annuals), herbs, canned goods, baked goods, honey, soaps, lotions, handmade natural beeswax candles, jams, jellies, and wine.

Fresh fruits (in season): strawberries, black raspberries, red raspberries, blackberries, gooseberries, watermelons, canta-



loupes, melons, apples, peaches, nectarines, pears, grapes, and rhubarb.

Fresh veggies (in season): collard greens, turnip



greens, lettuce, summer squash, butternut squash, cucumbers, tomatoes, onions, new potatoes, sweet potatoes, sweet corn, eggplant, zucchini, green beans, butter beans, turnips, bell peppers, sweet peppers, habanero pep-

pers, arugula, asparagus, beets, cabbage, garlic, green onions, kale, kohlrabi, okra, peas, radishes, and pumpkins.

Bedding plants, annuals, perennials, cut flowers, and herbs: butterfly weed, gooseber-

ries, poppies, ferns, cone flowers, mandevilla, bouganvilla, hibiscus, petunias, pansies, mums, basil, cilantro, lavender, thyme, peppermint, aster, and a wide variety of hanging baskets.
